- ✓ 7QpapEpJer Letter of Jeremiah 7Q2 Letter of Jeremiah verses 43–44 Greek Hasmonean Epistle of Jeremiah. On papyrus. [408]
- ✓ 7Q3 Unidentified 7Q3 Greek Herodian Unknown biblical text [409]
- ✓ 7Q4 Unidentified 7Q4 Greek Hasmonean Unknown biblical text [410]
- ✓ 7Q5 Unidentified 7Q5 Greek Herodian Unknown biblical text. Believed by some to be Mark 6:52–53 [411]
- ✓ 7Q6–18 Unidentified 7Q6–18 Greek Hellenistic-Roman; Herodian Very tiny unidentified fragments written on papyrus [79]
- ✓ 7Q papImprint Unidentified 7Q19 Greek Herodian Unidentified papyrus imprint. Very tiny fragments written on papyrus [412]

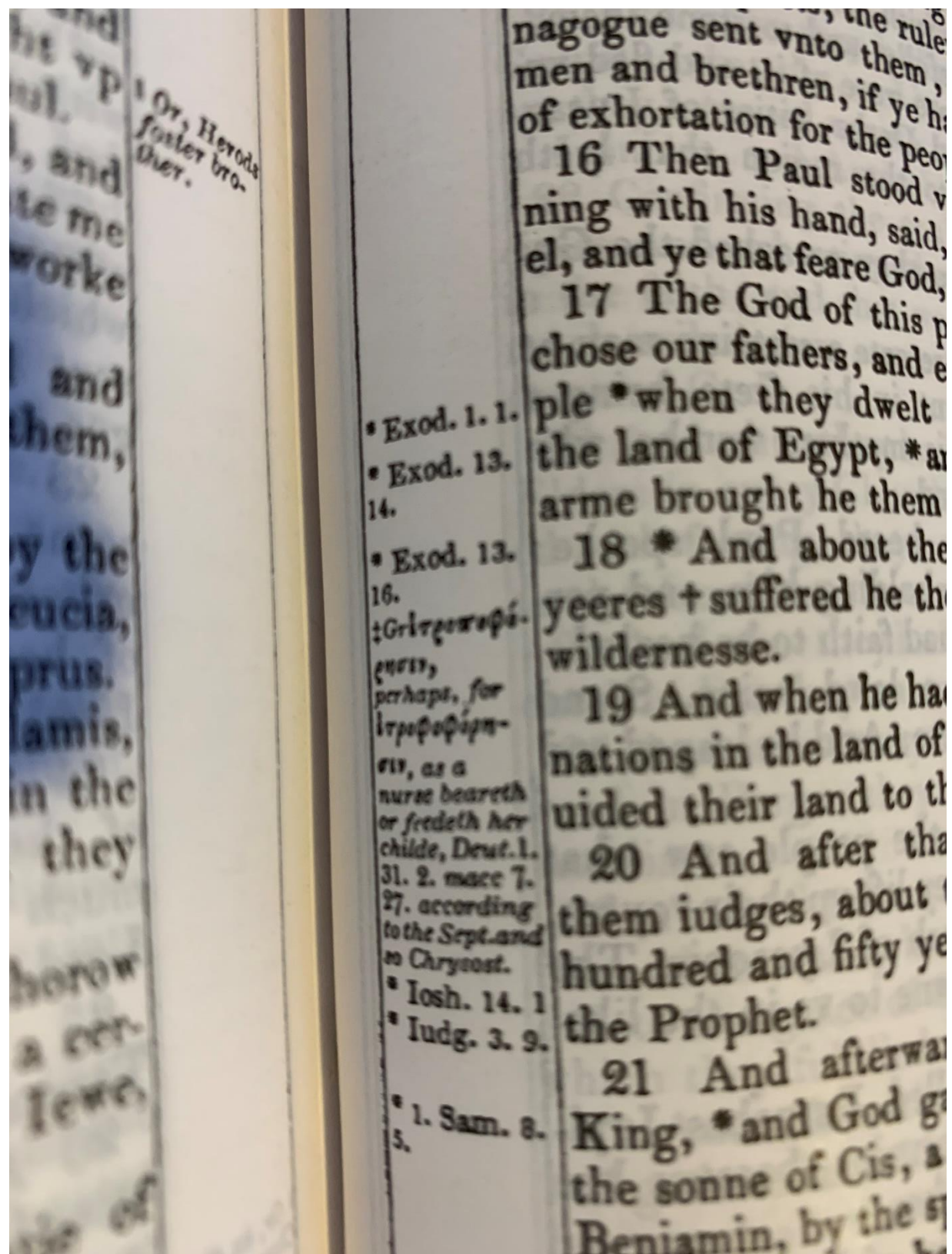
Justin Martyr defended the Septuagint, and accused the Jews of taking things out of their newer translations. Justin died in 165 AD, about 19 years before Origen was born.
